#### MAY IN YOUR GARDEN By Irene Turner

With the cool nights, mildew can develop on vegetables, pumpkins, cucumber and zucchini as they are finished for the seasons just pull them out don't put them in your compost.

Mildew can also appears on Dahlias. hydrangeas, petunia. delphiniums and Easter daisies, these can be cut back just above the ground. Cut the dahlias to a leaf node about 8cm to stop the stems taking water to the bulbs, which can rot them.

#### VEGETABLES

Broad beans seed can go in now, they like to grow in the cooler weather. Dig compost and a light dressing of fertilizer into the soil before planting.

Onions seedling white can also go in now.

#### **FLOWERS**

Seedlings of calendula, stocks, wallflower, alyssum, poppies, pansy, viola and verbena.



Divide perennial plants such as polyanthus, Russell lupin and deiphiniums. Give them a some fertilizer and some compost. Lift gladiola bulbs and store them in a airy shed, either place them in dry saw dust, or hang them in a old onion bag.

#### PLANT OF THE MONTH CATMINT Nepeta cataria

True catmint grows as a mounded bush to 80cm. It has square stems and grey-green, heart shaped downy leaves with an aromatic fragrance. The Flowers are usually white with pink marking, and grow in whorls in the leaf



axils at the top of the plant. Smaller species grows to 60cm mauve-blue flowers.

Catmint grows well in most soils as long as the drainage is good. They like full sun

and like the coastal regions. Cut back the flower head when the flowers have finished.

Catmint is grown from dividing clumps, or from seed sown in spring. Take tip cutting taken in spring. Catmint are very attractive to cats, if you have cats you may need to cover the plant while young. Nepetalactone is the active chemical found in catmint. It repels some insects and also a constituent of one of the pheromones, given off by aphids, which attracts parasitic braconid wasps.

Scientists in United Kingdom are using the pheromones extracted from catmint to attract these wasps, to use as soon as the aphids become active. Fresh catmint leaves sprinkled along ants trail will repel them. When planted around onions patches will repel onions maggots. A spray made from the leaves can be used as a general insect repellent. Catmint oil has been used to kill head lice and catmint can be grown around the vegetable garden and near houses to repel mice and rats.

#### Spray Recipe.

Pour IIt of boiling water over two firmly packed cupfuls of leaves. Leave to steep until cool. Strain and use within a few hours.

#### Fire at Weekender at Oallen

The family who owned the property were devastated to discover the damage when they arrived close to midnight on Thursday 1st April. They were planning to spend the Easter Break at their farm along with other members of their family.

The damage included 20 tyres being completely incinerated, plus the internal home contents, beds, bunks, lounges, gas refrigerator, gas stove, steel storage cabinets, cupboards, dressing table, coffee table, 9 kg. gas bottles and petrol tanks in the cars etc., there must have been considerable black toxic smoke, high flames, noise and several loud explosions when the fire occurred.

The fire was not reported and is currently under investigation by the police.




