Rhubarb Jam

2kg (4lb) rhubarb
1 cup (250ml) water
¼ cup (65ml) lemon juice
5cm (2") piece fresh root ginger
1 ½ kg (3lb) sugar
½ cup finely chopped crystallized ginger

Wash & trim the rhubarb and cut into 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ cm (1") pieces.

Put the rhubarb, water & lemon juice into a saucepan & bring to the boil.

Peel & slightly crush the ginger & add to the rhubarb.

Reduce heat & simmer until the rhubarb is soft. Remove the ginger.

Add the sugar & cook over a low heat, stirring constantly, until the sugar is dissolved.

Stir in the crystallized ginger & bring to the boil. Boil rapidly for about 10 minutes or until the jam has reached the setting point.

Pour into warm sterilized jars & seal immediately.
