

Transport Survey

With petrol prices now around \$1.40 per litre and likely to get higher as the world economy gobbles up supply, it is going to get increasingly difficult for people in rural areas to access cheap, efficient transport options.

We need to start developing alternatives now in order to iron out the problems and maximize the potential before the real energy crisis hits. Recent industry commentators have raised the spectre of two, three or even four dollars per litre of petrol in the foreseeable future. A few years ago \$1.40 per litre was unthinkable.

It is for this reason that I am hoping to establish a community transport scheme for the people of Bungonia and Windellama.

To this effectively I need some help in order to turn the idea into a legal and practical reality. We cannot rely on governments to help us cope in the future. That ideology has passed.

I am currently thinking along the lines of establishment of a transport co-op or incorporated association. This will not be directed at personal profit for any person, other than savings in petrol costs that may potentially be the result. I am investigating a variety of options ranging from a centralised car pool system through to leasing of an appropriate vehicle.

An interesting fact about Hepburn is that although she sang all the songs during the filming of the movie, her voice was dubbed for the final version.


