





## FIRE SEASON ENDS 30<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 2008

## BEFORE YOU BURN

The Southern Tablelands Zone **MUST** be notified 24 hours before you light the fire, during business hours 9am to 5pm and by 3.30pm on Friday afternoons. (Rural Fires Regulations 2002 Part 5 Sec 34 3B). As a courtesy notify The Brigade Captain Lynton Roberts **4844 5118** 24hrs before you light.

### **NOTIFICATION OF BURNING – (Outside of Bush Fire Danger Period)**

Although burning off is allowed outside the bush Fire Danger Period (1<sup>st</sup> April – 30<sup>th</sup> September) the following requirements are required: -

- \* Make sure the area around the fire is clear and safe and that some form of fire suppression equipment is available just in case.
- \* Notify your immediate neighbours 24 hours before you light the fire. If you cannot contact them directly, place a note in their mailbox or through the gate chain and so on as this is an attempt to notify them.
- \* The Southern Tablelands Zone **MUST** be notified 24 hours before you light the fire, during business hours 9am to 5pm and by 3.30pm on Friday afternoons. (Rural Fires Regulations 2002 Part 5 Sec 34 3B).

- \* Notify the Local Brigade Captain 24 hours before you light the fire (as a courtesy).
- \* Please check with the Fire Control Centre to see if a permit or a hazard reduction Certificate is required.

Always be very careful when burning off, ensure the burn-off has been completely extinguished before leaving the site.

# Landcare Update



A very busy bee was held at "Daraglen" on Saturday 29 March to stabilize the creek. The work involved fencing off an area where the creek had eroded and placing matting on the creek bed which was secured with pegs and rocks. There is still more to be done – there are trees to be planted. Richard Stone from Braidwood also attended.

On the 15th April several members of Windellama Landcare together with two Catchment Authority officers visited "Ravenswood" at Bullamalita. The owner was seeking advice on how to stop degradation of a chain of ponds on his property and he was advised to have the effected area fenced off. Windellama Landcare may be involved in any work carried out.

A grant has been received from the Sydney Catchment Authority for a trial involving dung beetles. The aim is to study dung beetles on a range of grazing enterprises consisting of different stock types including alpacas, horses, goats, sheep and cattle with a view to improving agriculture and water quality. The trial will be conducted on four local properties.

Our next activity will be held on **Saturday 24 May** when we will revisit several previous projects to determine their success or otherwise. This should be informative for new members with no labour involved.

We will be meeting at John & Marian Pearce's at *Glencoe*, 243 Sandy Point Road at 9.30am. A barbecue lunch will be provided on the day, so please let us know for catering purposes if you will be coming.


